Review of Draft NWPs

- Notes:
 - No changes to limits.
 - No changes to how impacts quantified.
- Concerns:
 - Certifying Draft NWPs
 - Reopener Clauses
 - Certification Request included only specific NWPs
 - NWP 27 Ecological Reference Definition
- Flags:
 - NWP A Fish Passage
 - NWP 56 Finfish Mariculture Activities
 - General Condition 25. Water Quality
 - Addition of point source discharge into waters of the US.



Reopener Clause

If the final issued General Permit for Nationwide Permits changes significantly, the Division of Water may opt to deny certification for this permit. [Statements A and D and citations KRS 224.70- 110, 401 KAR 10:030, Section 1(3)(b) & Section 1(4)(b); and 401 KAR 10:031, Section 2 & Section 4]
